2021-2022 Houston County High School Class Placement Audition Requirements:

Below are the audition requirements for placement in band classes at HCHS. Every student who wishes to participate in a band class will be able to do so. The audition process helps us to place your child in a class that best suits their individual needs and the needs of the program. Auditions for the ensembles will be on April 14 from 2:00-6:00. Any student wishing to audition must be registered by 5:15. Registration will be in the HCHS Band Room and auditions will be at the high school on a first come, first served basis. Anyone who does not audition but wants to participate will be placed in Concert Band II. **THERE WILL BE NO MAKE UP DATES FOR THESE AUDITIONS!** This audition will also serve as the audition for Jazz Band if you wish to participate in Jazz Band.

SCALE REQUIREMENTS:

For the audition, you will play as many scales as you can in three minutes. That can be one scale or twelve. The more you play, the higher you score. Scales do not need to be memorized; however, there will be bonus points for scales that are.
