VOLUNTEER POINTS SYSTEM

If our band students and directors are the heart and soul of our organization, our volunteers are the lifeblood. We depend on our volunteers to help at every event the band participates in to be successful. To provide you with a guide as to how much your service is needed, we put together a point system that helps quantify how much you are contributing as well as the level of involvement of the volunteer task. We ask that each band family have a goal of earning 25 volunteer points for the year. We welcome you to go above and beyond that!

Each family can accumulate points by volunteering at various band events during the season and attending Booster Meetings. A minimum of 25 points must be earned to attain \$30 credit towards their band fees. Points can be accumulated beginning (6/1/2022) until (4/30/2023) of the following year.

Serve as the official committee chairperson for one of the major committee positions: Uniforms, Transportation, Props, 3 rd Quarter Break/Band meals, Chaperone Coordinator, Volunteer Coordinator; fulfilling all duties as the position requires	8
Work a full Concessions shift for a home game	6
Work a full Concessions cleanup day	3
Work as a Chaperone for a home game	1
Work as a Chaperone for an away game	2
Work as a chaperone for an official band trip (Overnight) (only qualifies if they pay their own way; no credit will be given if the band booster org pays for their trip)	2
Work as a chaperone for a band competition	2
Work to serve 3 rd quarter break at a home game	1
Work as a member of the transportation crew at a home game	3
Work as a member of the transportation crew at an away game	3
Work as a member of the transportation crew at a band competition	4
Work as a member of the Props Crew at a workday	3
Work as a member of the Props Crew at a band competition	4
Work as a member of both Props Crew and Transportation at a band competition	5
Work a volunteer shift for LGPE	1
Work as a volunteer for Super Saturday	2
Attend Band Booster Meetings throughout the year (only 1 point per meeting per family regardless of how many family members attend)	1

*ACCUMULATED POINTS ARE VALID DURING THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR ONLY AND DO NOT CARRY FORWARD TO FUTURE SCHOOL YEARS.

*VOLUNTEER POINTS HAVE NO CASH VALUE AND CANNOT BE REIMBURSED OR REFUNDED MONETARILY AT THE CONCLUSION OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR.

ALL VOLUNTEERS MUST HAVE A COMPLETED BACKGROUND CHECK ON FILE. NO EXCEPTIONS

Guidelines:

- Volunteer slots will be limited on a per game/per event basis
- Signups for volunteer slots will be a first come, first serve basis
- Volunteers who sign up for slots and do not show up or do not fulfil the duties as assigned will no longer be permitted to sign up and will not be eligible to earn points
- Volunteer points will only be earned by those who sign up for shifts during the sign up period and fulfil the entire volunteer duty as prescribed.
- Volunteer points are only earned by the parents/guardians. Children/siblings/anyone under 18 cannot earn volunteer points.
- Band students can earn volunteer hours which do not count towards the volunteer points system.
- *Band Night counts as an away game for this system*

Concessions: Volunteers must work the entire concessions shift, from set up until clean up is done. Volunteers must arrive on time and dressed to work. Volunteers must stay and work the entire time, or they will not receive credit. Volunteers must work where they are asked to by the Ways and Means coordinators.

- Chaperones, home games: Chaperones will help in and out of the stands with students as needed and help with food and water at the game. *Chaperones will not receive both 3qr break and chaperone points as this is an expected duty*
- Chaperones, away games/competitions: Volunteers must be present at load up and ride the bus to the away game/competition. Chaperones will monitor bus activity, help in and out of the stands with students as needed, and help with food and water at the away events. *Chaperones will not receive both 3qr break and chaperone points as this is an expected duty*
- Account credit will be limited to one \$25 off credit per band member per year
- Points are only accumulated for one band student at a time. Points will NOT be doubled for sibling band students.
- Parents and volunteers with multiple students in the band can earn points for multiple children; however, there is no overlap in points. Points will be earned on a per student basis.
